### Description

The Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN) is responsible for direct care to a patient population including medication administration, data collection, and documentation of patients' conditions and notification to the Registered Nurse/physician of any adverse patient findings. The LPN, in collaboration with the Registered Nurse and directed by the physician, assumes responsibility for following the plan of care and evaluation of the effectiveness of the plan. Any other duties/responsibilities assigned by your supervisor.

### Qualifications

This position requires a valid State license as a Licensed Practical Nurse, CPR and ACLS are required. At least two (2) years of experience in the acute care setting is preferred.

Ability to maintain assigned worked hours: Requires endurance to perform tasks over long periods of work hours.
