Financial Assistance Offered

Atoka County Medical Center's mission is to provide accessible, quality health-care services to our community that are quality-driven, customer-focused and cost-effective. As part of this mission, Atoka County Medical Center offers financial assistance through its Financial Assistance Program to patients unable to pay for emergency or medically necessary care.

Eligibility Requirements and Assistance Offered

Eligibility for financial assistance is based on multiple factors, including condition and care required, insurance coverage or other sources of payment (including personal injury claims), income (Federal Poverty Level guidelines used to determine the amount of financial assistance offered), family size.

Patients must comply with the application process, including submitting tax returns, bank statements, and pay stubs, as well as completing the application process for all available sources of assistance, including Medical Assistance.

How to Apply for Assistance

The patient or any person involved in the care of the patient, including a family member or provider, can express financial concerns during the patient's care. The patient or responsible party will then be encouraged to complete a Financial Assistance Application.

Financial assistance is limited to medical care provided at Atoka County Medical Center. Atoka County Medical Center will uphold the confidentiality and dignity of each patient, and any information submitted for consideration of financial assistance will be treated as protected health information under the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPPA).

A patient determined to be eligible for financial assistance may not be charged more than the amounts generally billed for emergency or other medically necessary care to patients who have insurance for such care.
